The City of Longview is developing a plan for replacement of the Washington Way Bridge over Lake Sacajawea and would like your input. Please join us at our open house and give us your opinions regarding options for the design of new bridge.

What is this Project?

The City received a federal grant to replace the Washington Way Bridge over Lake Sacajawea. The existing bridge is an 80 year old timber structure that requires yearly maintenance and repair. The new bridge will meet current design standards and improve safety. Public input, combined with analyses of future traffic, bicycle, and pedestrian needs, structural design limitations, aesthetics, and permit requirements will be used to develop the preferred bridge design.

What will happen at the Open House?

At the Open House, the project design team will introduce the project, provide bridge design options, construction phasing and detour impacts, and the project schedule, and will gather public input and feedback in order to develop a preferred bridge alternative.
